## Mentor for the Art of Nature: Application Deadline April 26th

The San Angelo Museum of Fine Arts is seeking 3 responsible, physically active Art, Kinesiology, Science and Education majors (juniors or seniors) to work as camp counselors at our Art of Nature camp in San Angelo from June 3<sup>th</sup> – June 28<sup>th</sup>. Camp mentors will need to be available for Art of Nature Camp Training from May 22<sup>nd</sup> – May 31<sup>st</sup>, specific times and dates TBD. Camp Mentors will report directly to the Curator of Education and Lead Mentors. Pay is \$10 an hour.

## **Responsibilities include:**

- Serve as positive role models for campers (ages 7-12), ensure camper safety and encourage participation and engagement in camp activities
- Implement camp curriculum (art and science activities) and other activities for campers, and keep camp on schedule
- Be aware of medical and emergency information for campers to ensure their safety

## The ideal candidate should possess the following characteristics:

- Proven experience working with children
- The ability to remain positive and collected under stressful situations
- Physically active, enjoys outdoor activities and is able to walk and hike at least 1/2 mile
- An interest in art, science, museums and/or nature
- A creative problem solver and self-motivator
- Dependable, organized and friendly
- Open to trying and learning new things
- Team player, works extremely well with others

This position is full-time/temporary, averaging no more than 30-40 hours per week from May 22<sup>nd</sup> – June 28th<sup>th</sup>. Chosen candidates MUST be available to work the entire month of June.
