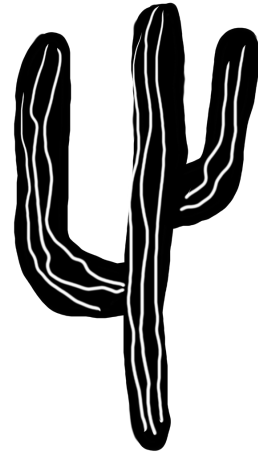


# Bison Track Printmaking



## Supplies Provided:

- Brown, black, red, green paint
- Orange, red, yellow, tan, and brown crayons
- Bison hoof linocuts
- Cactus petal and cactus flower linocuts
- Paper

## How To:

1. Choose one of the western landscapes on your table. (this will be your reference)
2. Using the crayons, try your best to draw the landscape you picked out.
3. Choose between the cacti and bison linocuts on the table and figure out where you want to place them on your paper.
4. Once you have picked your linocuts and are ready for paint, go to one of the instructors. They will put paint onto your plate and give you a roller.
5. Roll your roller onto your paint and gently roll the paint onto the linocut.
6. Grab your ready linocut and press it onto your paper. Make sure to press down on the lino before lifting it up.
7. Then gently lift your linocut off of your paper.
8. Do this as many times as you like, until you feel like your print is finished. Make sure that your paint is dry before stamping on another cacti or track!
