Bison Track Printmaking

Supplies Provided:

- Brown, black, red, green paint
- Orange, red, yellow, tan, and brown crayons
- Bison hoof linocuts
- Cactus petal and cactus flower linocuts
- Paper

How To:

- 1. Choose one of the western landscapes on your table. (this will be your reference)
- 2. Using the crayons, try your best to draw the landscape you picked out.
- 3. Choose between the cacti and bison linocuts on the table and figure out where you want to place them on your paper.
- 4. Once you have picked your linocuts and are ready for paint, go to one of the instructors. They will put paint onto your plate and give you a roller.
- 5. Roll your roller onto your paint and gently roll the paint onto the linocut.
- 6. Grab your ready linocut and press it onto your paper. Make sure to press down on the lino before lifting it up.
- 7. Then gently lift your linocut off of your paper.
- 8. Do this as many times as you like, until you feel like your print is finished. Make sure that your paint is dry before stamping on another cacti or track!
